Ten boroughs in Mexico City and 13 municipalities in the State of Mexico will be affected by water rationing, starting Saturday.

- Four neighborhoods in Iztapalapa, already lacking a steady flow of potable water, will be affected. But it won't only be neighborhoods on the outskirts that get hit by the measure. Del Valle in the Benito Juárez borough is one of many in the central part of the capital that will be affected.
- · Some of Mexico City's wealthier neighborhoods will also be affected. Polanco, Lomas de Chapultepec and Lomas de Virreyes are among the posh neighborhoods that will lack water this weekend.
- In the State of Mexico, Naucalpan, Huixquilucan and Tlalnepantla will be among those places affected.
