Trying to fix the water problem

On Thursday, the excavation of a 62-kilometer tunnel part of the Lumbra Cero – the biggest hydraulic engineering project of its type in the world – is due to begin. It aims to drain 300 cubic meters of sewage and pluvial water from the metropolitan area in the Valley of Mexico.
